Online Safeguarding Deets and Squares'

'Deets and Squares' is money laundering which can involve children. 'Deets' is slang for bank details and 'Squares' are credit/debit cards. Social media messages are sometimes used to ask children if they want to earn money, in which children then become 'money mules' by giving their bank details to fraudsters in exchange for money, becoming accessories to crime. The internet brings the world to our doorstep so it is important that you remind children never to share any personal information online. Also try to keep conversations open so children feel comfortable coming to you with any concerns. Various information sources are available, for example the Money Mules website.
